WAITRESS ARRESTED AFTER USING CUSTOMER'S CREDIT CARD

Bluffton Police Department arrested Jaquitta Kinlaw on February 1, 2010 for unlawfully using another person's credit card.

On January 29, 2010 Bluffton Police were contacted by an individual who believed his credit card number was stolen. According to the complainant, a fraudulent charge was made on January 25, 2010 in the amount of \$682.62. However, he still had his credit card in possession. The credit card was last used at Bluffton Café by the complainant on January 14, 2010.

The investigation into this incident revealed that the fraudulent charge was used to pay a cell phone bill of Jaquitta Kinlaw who was his waitress at Bluffton Café. It was discovered that Kinlaw wrote down the complainant's credit card number and used it to pay her cell phone bill.

Kinlaw was arrested on February 1, 2010 for Financial Transaction Card Fraud [16-14-60(a)(1)] and transported to the Beaufort County Detention Center.
