WEEKEND BURGLARY SOLVED

February 8, 2010

In the early morning hours of February 7, 2010 a resident of 487 Gardners Lane discovered that her home was burglarized. It was reported that over \$5,500.00 worth of electronics and jewelry was stolen.

Investigation into this incident revealed that the rear sliding door was pried open with a screwdriver. A number of computers, cameras, a flat screen television and jewelry were taken. Information led investigators to the arrest of two suspects; Nelson Herrera and Luis Zapata. A third suspect, Cesar Sanchez, is still at large.

The majority of stolen items were located and returned to the victim. Herrera and Zapata were arrested for Burglary – First Degree (16-11-0311) and transported to the Beaufort County Detention Center. Sanchez has an active arrest warrant for Burglary.
