UPDATE ON WEEKEND BURGLARY

February 9, 2010

On February 9, 2010 Cesar Sanchez turned himself in at the Bluffton Police Department. He is one of three individuals accused of burglarizing a residence in the Farm over the weekend. The other two individuals, Nelson Herrera and Luis Zapata, were arrested yesterday.

In the early morning hours of February 7, 2010 a resident of 487 Gardners Lane discovered that her home was burglarized. It was reported that over \$5,500.00 worth of electronics and jewelry was stolen.

Investigation into this incident revealed that the rear sliding door was pried open with a screwdriver. A number of computers, cameras, a flat screen television and jewelry were taken. All stolen items have been recovered and returned to the victim.
