INDIVIDUAL ARRESTED ON MULTIPLE FELONY CHARGES

January 31, 2010

A domestic incident that occurred yesterday ended in the suspect involved being arrested on multiple felony charges.

On January 30, 2010 at approximately 1430 hours officers were dispatched to the area of US Highway 278 and Buckwalter Parkway in reference to a domestic dispute that occurred between two individuals in different vehicles. Officers were able to intervene when both vehicles pulled into Berkley Place at 100 Berkley Place, Bluffton, SC.

Investigation into this incident found that the suspect, Belvin Page, was following his wife, Jeanette Rollie. While following her, Page was waiving a handgun at her and attempting to run her off the road. When Page was being detained, he would not comply with officer's orders to take his hands out of his pockets. Page was wrestled to the ground and handcuffed. Before being able to place handcuffs on him, a number of illegal drugs fell out of his pockets.

As the investigation continued after Page was arrested, officers recovered a pill bottle of crack cocaine, a handgun from his vehicle, and eight individually wrapped small plastic bags of marijuana. Page was charged with the following felony crimes; Criminal Domestic Violence High and Aggravated Second Offense (16-25-20), Possession with intent to Distribute Crack Cocaine (44-53-375), Unlawful Carrying of a Firearm (16-23-20), Possession with intent to Distribute Marijuana (44-53-370D), Distribution of a Controlled Substance within a Half Mile of a School (44-53-445), and Resisting Arrest (16-9-320).

Page was transported to the Beaufort County Detention Center to await a bond hearing.
