Man Arrested for Pointing a Pistol

Today, July 7, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. Bluffton Police Officers responded to a man pointing a handgun.

Investigation into the incident revealed that the victim went to Evans Capers residence at 10 Henry Jones Drive to discuss a vehicle issue. According to the victim, he owns a vehicle that Capers is making monthly payments to him for. He went to Capers residence because he was behind on payments. After discussing the problem, Capers told the victim that he had something inside his residence for him and asked him to wait. Capers came out pointing a silver handgun at the victim. The victim ran from the location and called 9-1-1 for assistance.

Evans Capers was arrested for Pointing and Presenting a Firearm (SC Statute 16-23-410). The weapon Capers used was not located when officers arrived on scene.
